



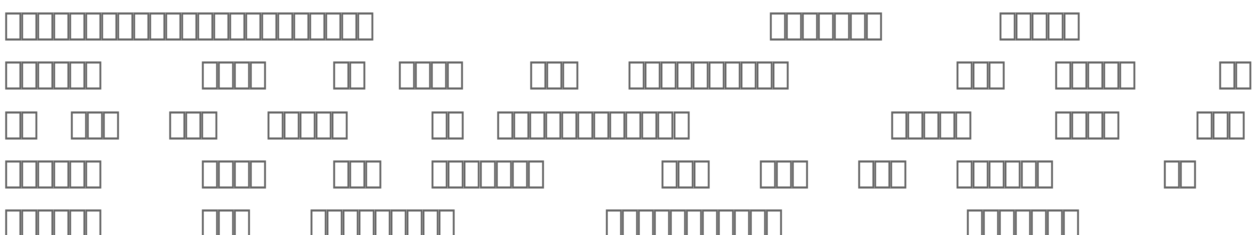

Climate information and services (CIS) are essential for decision-makers to understand the risks and opportunities associated with climate change. CIS can help to reduce the vulnerability of communities and ecosystems to the adverse impacts of climate change, and to enhance their resilience. CIS can also help to identify and develop opportunities for adaptation and mitigation, and to support the development of climate-resilient and low-carbon societies.

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) is a global organization that works to promote sustainable development and reduce poverty. UNDP has been instrumental in supporting countries to develop and implement CIS, and to integrate climate change considerations into their development planning and policy. UNDP has also been a leader in the development of the Climate Information and Services (CIS) framework, which provides a common language and approach for CIS across different sectors and regions.
